



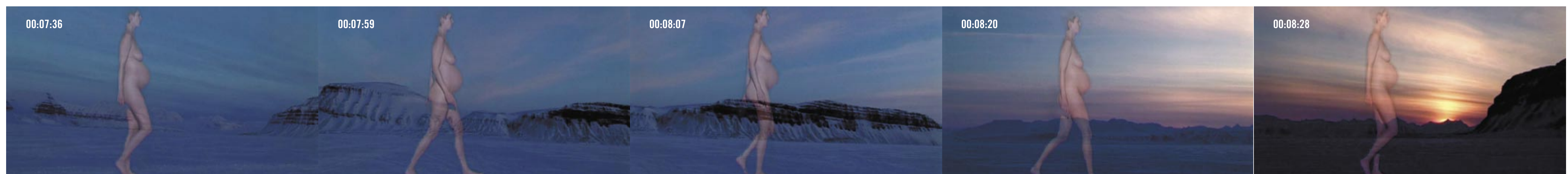
David Buckland, *Falling Ice* 2004
